Dear Friends and Supporters of A Storehouse For Jesus,

We are not going to have a fall issue of our newsletter, *Two Coats*, but wanted to make sure that you received information on our Thanksgiving and Christmas programs (available to Davie County residents only). Please share this information with others you feel would like to be a sponsor or assist in any way.

Additionally, we wanted to briefly share a few other current items with you.

- The Ghana mission team recently returned from their 10th trip. The team was comprised of 63 members coming together from North Carolina, Tennessee, Ohio and Ghana. 394 Ghanaians made professions of faith, 1,552 medical and surgical patients were treated, 4,768 medications were dispensed and more than 500 pairs of reading glasses given.

- **2010 Fall/Winter Closings** -
  - Distribution Ministries** will be closed November 24th and 25th, and December 20th - 30th. *A local agency will be available to cover any emergencies that may arise. Note - we are regularly closed Friday, Saturday and Sunday.*
  - Medical Ministries - Pharmacy** will be closed November 23rd - 25th; December 21st - 23rd, 28th and 29th. (Pharmacy will be open December 20th, 27th and 30th; **Medical Clinic** will be closed November 25th and December 23rd. Medical Clinic will see patients on December 30th; **Chronic Care Clinic** will be closed November 23rd, December 21st and 28th.
- Coming soon to a computer near you - Our website is being revamped and revised. It is our intention to create a useful tool to provide the public with news of ongoing programs, current needs, hours and closings. - A big thank you to Davidson County Community College and all gardeners who brought produce this summer, as well as all who brought in school supplies. What a blessing! Within two days we gave 5,535 school supplies to 140 Davie County families (360 students). Bookbags are still needed and are needed on a continual basis.
- Please remember us with your donations of food, hygiene, cleaning items and gently used clothing, household items, etc. We are here to accept items Monday - Thursday, from 8:30 am - 5 pm (we are often here after 5 pm) and on Saturday, from 9 am - 1 pm.

- ☞ If sponsoring multiple families, we ask you to please bag all like food items together. (For example: If you sponsor 5 families, put 5 cans of sweet potatoes in one bag, 5 boxes of instant potatoes in another bag, etc.) This hopefully will make bagging easier for you and for the volunteers at Storehouse. *Thank you!*
- ☞ Sponsors are welcome to include a Bible, tract or flyer with their church's upcoming holiday services.
- ☞ Sponsors are asked to deliver meals to Storehouse, on Sunday, November 14, from 1 - 3 pm.

## Christmas Program Sponsor Information

- ☞ Gifts are provided to children (ages birth – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade), senior citizens (ages 65+) and special needs adults (ages 19 – 64 ~ the majority are nursing home residents without families).
- ☞ You are asked to purchase **two NEW toys and two NEW clothing items** (suggestions will be provided). **PLEASE, NO USED ITEMS FOR CHRISTMAS.**  
**Gifts must be appropriate for a Christian ministry.**
- ☞ **DO NOT** wrap children's gifts. You may include wrap, bows and tape. You may wrap gifts for seniors and special needs adults. If you do wrap, place an itemized list of items enclosed on wrapped gifts.
- ☞ Place gifts in clear bag(s) and securely tape (do not staple) a large tag with recipient's assigned number, age and sex written with big, bold lettering.  
If more than 1 bag per recipient, please indicate (example – 1 of 2, 2 of 2).
- ☞ **Gifts are to be brought to A Storehouse For Jesus (675 E. Lexington Road – Hwy. 64 E. – Mocksville) on December 2<sup>nd</sup> (9 am – 2 pm), 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> (9 am – 6 pm) or December 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> (9 am – 7:30 pm).**
