

A STOREHOUSE FOR JESUS MEDICAL MINISTRIES HISTORY

In 2000, A Storehouse For Jesus expanded its services to provide a **Medical Clinic** for Davie County residents who are uninsured, do not have Medicaid and are within the 200% Federal Poverty Level.

Since the Medical Clinic opened, the Storehouse has been offering the services of the **Medication Assistance Program (MAP)**. MAP allows us to order free medications from pharmaceutical companies for qualifying patients.

The **Pharmacy** received its license from the N.C. Pharmacy Board in 2001. The Pharmacy serves Davie County residents who are unable to purchase their medications and those that are uninsured (including Medicaid). Please pray with us for funding, as operating a free Pharmacy is very costly. The Pharmacy dispensed \$799,616 worth of medications in 2007. The budgeted expense for actual Storehouse costs to run the Pharmacy in 2008 is \$40,000.

Due to the overflow of patients who were not able to be seen during the Medical Clinic, a **Chronic Care Clinic** began in 2003. The Chronic Care Clinic targets patients who have been pre-approved in the Medical Clinic and who have chronic illnesses.

Also In 2003, the Storehouse began providing the services of a **Dental Clinic**. The Dental Clinic serves patients (including children) in Davie County who are within 200% of the Federal Poverty Level and are without dental insurance or Medicaid.

In 2006, we held our first **Eye Clinic**, as well as increased our **Medical Clinic** hours by adding clinics on two Wednesday evenings a month.

A **Diabetes Clinic** began in 2007. This clinic targets the more than 50% of our patients that are plagued by diabetes, by providing education and the means to manage this debilitating disease.

We are blessed to have a dedicated volunteer staff and praise God for the opportunity to give improved medical and dental care to Davie County residents. Please pray with us for additional staffing and for the finances to not only continue, but to expand, our services in the coming years.
