# A WORD FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Hello Friends,

y car radio is on a Christian radio station, "The Message." Listening is daily inspiration to me, always uplifting, and reminding me that God is near. I recently heard the song, "Gonna Be Alright," by Ryan Ellis. Through this song, God says to me routinely, NO worries, NO doubts, NO anxiety, NO depression. It's gonna be alright - God is all knowing. He never gives us a command that He does not enable us to fulfill. He knows our needs, supports our dreams, shares His love, and forgives our sins when we ask. This unconditional love will last a lifetime - if we submit to His will. There are so many things wrong with our world today. Things beyond our control. However, I believe (and have witnessed) that if we pray ardently, with expectations, God will answer. He will bring peace from panic and joy from distress. He is always present. "God moments" happen when you least expect them.

For the past several months there has been an increase in the number of families coming to Storehouse for help. At the same time our food resources have decreased. Our monthly allotment from Second Harvest Food Bank was significantly reduced due to their receiving less from multiple resources. In addition, our Food Coordinator was having trouble finding items in the grocery stores to stock shelves in our Shopping Area. This has been a snowball effect

that has been out of our control. I was deeply troubled, wondering how we were going to "fix this." I prayed each day, and one week later God gave me an answer. It was not how WE were going to fix it, but how HE was going to fix it! I understood His plan clearly. A few (hopefully temporary) changes were needed. Clients are currently getting slightly less food items from the Shopping Area. We returned to the original plan of serving Davie and the five surrounding counties (Davidson, Rowan, Iredell, Yadkin, and Forsyth). I have since witnessed God in action! A volunteer excitedly told me we had received 400 pounds of food that day . . . a God moment!

Also, A Storehouse For Jesus has been in need of interpreters for quite a while. Again, within a week, two individuals came to us offering help - one an 18-year-old interpreting for his mother, a shopper, and a young lady offering help one day a week . . . another God moment!

What a gift we receive if we are in a relationship with God. HE is our Father - loving, listening, guiding, protecting, comforting, giving, and always faithful in providing our needs. "It's gonna be alright," with God as our guide. Believe, trust and walk with Him.
